## Minutes of meeting held Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2007

### **Matters Arising**

- J.Gray has completed display boards for Parish Plan Roadshow and they have been sent for printing. Colour leaflets have been printed.
- Only 7 nominations (those of the existing councillors) have been submitted therefore there will be no election and no change.

### **Planning**

- approval Bridge House with conditions as to type of slate – must be wet laid.

### **Finance**

- The Audit Commission has appointed Alun Williams as External Auditor
- Accounts for 2006-7 were presented and approved
- Annual Governance Statement was approved.

**Parish Paths** LMP budget details have been received. J.Swannell has queried the amount as County appear to have included the Coast Path. He is awaiting their response.

J. Brookes reported that recent activity on the ‘path’ up to Zennor Quoit was due to a group from CASPN wishing to clean ‘St Senara’s Well’.

**Transport** J.Pozzi reported that at the March Transport Forum meeting a representative from First Great Western confirmed that the London-Penzance sleeper service is not to be withdrawn, it is in fact fully booked and will be re-furbished. They have a £200m 10-year plan which will include measures to relieve overcrowding. A new bus service, 201, is now operating 3 times a day between St Ives and Lands End.

A.Penhault reported that 300 maps went out over Easter; he will print the remaining old version and distribute.
