Minutes of meeting held Tues 12th February 2008

Planning

- Bosigran Climber's. J.Brookes declared interest as this is part of the ongoing Heath Project in which the N.T. is involved. He explained that the hedge is required to protect the property from stock in the conservation grazing scheme. It was agreed that the current proposal is not acceptable but that the PC would look on it more favourably if the hedge were set back 3m from the road and provided it was constructed in local stone and style.

Finance

- Precept after discussion it was agreed to raise the precept by 1%.

Parish Paths J.Swannell reported that he had relayed the views of the PC to A.Clough and requested that the destinations be routed on signs. He advised that the path upgrades, including the bridleway to Giant's Rock are to go ahead. He was thanked for his efforts.

Transport J.Pozzi presented a design which would incorporate three adverts on the timetable, which at £15 each would finance the printing onto the maps.
