Minutes of meeting held Tuesday 8th January 2008

Matters Arising

- C Burlton & Rachel Bray are booked for 19 Feb. Village hall has been booked.
- Rural Transport have offered up to £600 towards map/timetables. AP will get pro forma invoice from Headland and forward immediately.
- One Cornwall newsletter – “Trailer” information arrived too late for Penzance venue.
- Delia Webb has been contacted – proposed meeting 28th January – agreed.
- C.Penhaul reported that AP had attended the Town & Parish Forum Seminar and that PDC are taking a pragmatic view “*It will happen so make it happen the way you want it*” There will be a dedicated officer for each Parish. He recommended that a PC representative should attend the next PDC/forum meeting. Notes should be available.

Parish Paths J.Swannell reported that as a result of assessing the footpaths A.Clough is proposing that certain paths should be upgraded to “Gold” thus giving more income to the Parish and creating more Circular Walks. Also it is a statutory obligation that all footpaths from the public highway have signs that include an arrow and say “Public Footpath” they may also include destinations. The Parish can choose the type of sign. It was agreed that a simple wooden post not more than 1.5m high (shoulder height) with destinations where appropriate would be preferred. JL expressed concern that some posts were located on private land and that owners should be approached for permission – JS will contact A.Clough.
