## Minutes of Meeting held 8<sup>th</sup> July 2008

**Minutes of last meeting** were read and confirmed

### **Matters Arising**

- Telephone Exchange: PDC have confirmed there is no requirement for change of use so long as it is not lived in.
- Elections – It appears that 2013 is the preferred option for Cornwall
- Airwave LCC: MH has received record of correspondence between LCC and Andy Golay. Planning Application is expected in a few weeks. It was reported that Landowners are being approached by Airwave for alternative sites. I.Hamlett advised that Ambulance service implementation of Tetra system has been postponed to Jun 2009 due to various problems. After discussion it was agreed: to respond to Airwave LCC asking for more information and inviting them to a meeting, to contact all emergency services and discover how many malor incidents they have attended in Zennor in the last 3 years and to contact the AONB.

### **Planning:**

- Treveglos Cottage, Interest was declared by M.Hindley, J.Brookes, J.Lindfield, G.Osborne. Having studied the plans, and although meeting Inquorate it was decided that no observations would be recorded.

**Finance** Balance at Bank £ 1918.37, It was agreed to pay:

- Clerk's fees: £408.48,
- Zurich Insurance £205 for Insurance Renewal (no increase over last year so represents net decrease),
- Mermaid's Echo requested a donation towards printing costs. It was agreed, following discussion, to empower the Chairman and Vice chairman to make an interim payment of up to £50 if required, whilst further investigations and discussions continue.

**Parish Paths** J.Swannell reported that the First Cut is completed and presented his invoice for £580, which it was agreed to pay. He has had correspondence with A.Clough about replacement of signposts. Only two posts are scheduled to be replaced as there are currently insufficient funds to cover the whole Parish. Response to proposed joint funding scheme to be sent.
