## Minutes of meeting held Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 1009

**Minutes of last meeting** were read and confirmed.

### **Matters Arising**

- Airwave: AP reported that he and I Hamlett had attended the West Sub Area Planning Committee and spoken. Of the 12 councillors present none spoke in favour of the application. Several, including Cllr I Bailey had made their own investigations and or visited the site. A site meeting will be held on 20<sup>th</sup> July at 2.15, to which all those who have written to the Planning Dept. have been invited.
- Flooding: AP has sent map to Environment Agency. JL still pursuing uninsured losses issue and will chase up drainage map and uncompleted works.
- Poles mapping, some areas completed.
- Maps- 2000 printed, invoice to follow.

Bosporthennis: some residents have raised queries about work being done not being as per plans. JG has spoken to A.Golay and enforcement Officers will investigate.JB has copy of plans and NT are checking in connection with their covenant.

MH advised that several residents have expressed concern that the recent works at the Treveglos Farm car park has been done without planning consent. The PC will contact the Planning Dept to ascertain whether consent was required or not. JB advised that under the terms of the covenant the development will be looked at by the NT's Architectural Panel. The PC agreed that the seasonal use of the field had alleviated the parking problems in the village but there were fears that the centre of the village was becoming one big car park.
