Minutes of meeting held 10th June 2008

Matters Arising

- Airwave: the chairman read letters from LCC (Airwave) outlining the proposal and from J.McKenna of PDC explaining that LCC had only spoken to A.Golay of the planning dept. who advised them to contact the Parish Council.

After some discussion it was agreed that LCC letters should be forwarded to J.McKenna to show why the PC assumed PDC had been in discussion with LCC. PDC to be invited to special meeting, asap date tba Also to respond to LCC with request for further information about coverage etc

- One Cornwall – community network report of meeting held by Hayle Town Council.

Planning

- Carn Cobba – approval has been received
- Gear Farm – CP & AP declared interest - no objections
- Carn Galva – pre planning consultation. JB & LS declared interest all concerned about amount of signs. CP opposed to proposal to protect the “most spectacular road” AP suggested moving the Eastern grid further downhill with minimum signs. JL asked whether reduction in speed limit should be considered (as per Parish Plan) C.Catran expressed concern at potential number of cattle involved. JB confirmed that hedges would be constructed of local stone in traditional manner.
