Minutes of meeting held 13th March 2007

Minutes of last meeting read and confirmed

Matters Arising Brief discussion as to whether the work at Bosvean complied with “Like for like” condition, no conclusion reached.

Planning Bridge House (Wayside Museum) following examination of plans no observations were made.

Parish Plan Event: Parish Hall booked for 19th April. Display boards booked from PDC, their Regeneration dept has offered any help it can. Council reconfirmed its earlier decision to pay J.Gray for the work done to analyse the survey and produce display materials. A.Penhaul suggested that the final display board should present the top 10 priorities for inclusion in the Parish Plan. It was agreed to use the title “Parish Plan Roadshow” for the event. Cost of colour photocopying 83p per sheet. Unless a cheaper alternative can be found it was agreed to print 10 leaflets in colour and 50 black and white. A further meeting to plan the event is to be held 27th March.
