Matters Arising

- Co opt new councillor: the Chairman read communication from L.Scambler. In the absence of any other expression of interest L.Scambler was duly co-opted to the Parish Council. (prop A.Penhaul, sec G.Osborne)
- Bank mandate forms passed to signatories, C.Penhaul agreed to be third.
- Electoral Review: our response has been acknowledged. Details of Cornwall County Council response was discussed.

Planning

- Carn Cobba – agreed no observations
- Bosporthenis- J.Brookes declared interest as NT involved. Dan Cape explained the proposals. Council agreed to recommend Section 106: no residential use of barn, studio for own & family use only, Access to be traditional and sensitive to the area.
- Airwave (pre-planning consultation) was discussed. The proposal for a replica telegraph pole is in conflict with the Parish Plan which aims to have all poles removed from that area. Initial response to be sent but need to consult local residents. PDC have not involved the Parish in discussions so far despite personal assurance of their Chief Exec.

Parish Plan notes from the last open meeting have been received. Each councillor to draft a section of the Plan, to be discussed at extra meeting Tues 17th June.
