## Minutes of meeting held 13<sup>th</sup> Nov 2007

**Minutes** of last meeting & Interim meeting held 23<sup>rd</sup> October were read and confirmed

### **Matters Arising**

- Co-option of new member: after lengthy debate J.Brookes proposed that as only one candidate had formally expressed interest he should be co-opted, motion seconded by J.Lindfield and carried 3 votes to 2. Geoff Osborne was therefore co-opted to the Council.
- Payments to SILD (printing - £61) and M Hindley (£101.52 – Cornishman Ad.) were approved.

**Transport** J.Pozzi reported that the new schedule is operating promptly, and that stops at the hospital and Tesco are appreciated, but that some of the changes (e.g. loss of morning bus to Penzance and last bus to town Saturday Evening) are not working for users. She will be canvassing views of users prior to meeting with M Howarth on 7<sup>th</sup> December. J.Lindfield expressed the Council's support and appreciation for her efforts on behalf of the community
