## **Matters Arising**

- Website – J. Gray confirmed that there is nothing outstanding but that she will be making additions to the Links page and asked for a mention in the next Mermaid's Echo to encourage more contributions.
- Archiving – response from CRO has been received. M Hindley will contact them to see if any funds are available for private digitising, if not it was agreed that the Parish Council would fund this.
- Unitary Authority update: A.Penhaul reported on the recent meetings he attended and various items of correspondence were passed round. It was agreed to invite Steven Ford to the February meeting.
- It was agreed to make a donation of £20 to the Mermaid's Echo in appreciation of distribution of the leaflets.

- Seating for the Village Hall has arrived and the committee plan to show films, possibly on a monthly basis, and extend the use of the Hall with, for example, a Yoga group.

LMP Payment £324 has been advised by County. J.Swannell reported that the final cut was underway. J.Swannell said that the route from the top of Zennor Hill to the Quoit is currently almost impassable and although not a Definitive path, should be accessible as people come from around the world to go there. After lengthy discussion M.Hindley agreed to contact landowners about access to Zennor Quoit.

**Transport** Jenni Pozzi reported that Tim Andrewes has resigned from the Rural Transport Authority. The new officer, Colin Garrick has been approached about funding for next year's timetable. The winter timetable is not yet available. The bus service is running well and Western Greyhound have plans for future development co-ordinating services between St Ives & St Just around a "mini-hub" at Gurnard's Head. The sleeper service Penzance – Paddington has been saved and a £2m refurbishment is commencing.
